

Prolific proposals

The psychology research institute wants to support cross-programme group collaborations by making Prolific hours available. Colleagues at the Psychology Department (PhD/postdoc/permanent staff) are encouraged to apply for max. €1.000 worth of Prolific hours.

Deadline

Prolific Proposals can be submitted until Thursday 3rd of July '26.

Criteria

The Scientific Advisory Board (SAB) will check that the proposal meets the criteria. This will be a light review procedure:

- Write a proposal of max. 500 words. In the proposal, please state your research question/hypothesis, and briefly explain its (theoretical/applied) relevance. Next, describe the design of your study (i.e., questions/questionnaires/sample characteristics and size).
- It is allowed to involve external researchers, but your application should be submitted by at least 3 colleagues from 2 different psychology programme groups*.
- Budget: you can only apply for Prolific hours, up to the value of ~€1.000 (if more is needed, please explain, but this will be subjected to more in-depth review).
- Preferably, the projects start the latest in September '26. The Prolific hours must be used before 1st of March '27.
- Prices for prolific research can be found [here](#). Please take into account that the platform fee has already been covered, so you only need to pay for participant hours. If you are aiming for a specific sample, this may involve additional costs, please check with Prolific before submitting your application.

**You can submit an application with the brainstorm group during the Connecting Minds event, but it is also possible to create a new research team. Please take care that we would like to stimulate new collaborations (so great to have some new team members). There is no max. nr of team members.*
